

CITROËN TELEMATIC NAVIGATION SYSTEM

GETTING STARTED

On receipt of your Citroën vehicle, fitted with the NAVIDRIVE system, you will first need to initialize the NAVIDRIVE system for it to operate. The full operation manual is supplied with the vehicle in the document pack, along with 2 x CD ROM's, one is the System CD and the other is the Map disc, but a brief outline of the initialization procedure follows.

STEP ONE

With the vehicle stationary, engine running (idling), and parked, in the open so that the system may acquire satellite positioning (GPS), insert the "Telematic System" CD ROM, as shown on the right, into the CD drive of the Radio/Telematic unit in the dashboard, and allow the system to initialize, this should take approximately 10 minutes, these instructions are also on the back cover on the CD ROM case.



STEP TWO

Once the initialization procedure has finished, you will need to confirm the language, and voice gender, via the MENU function on the Radio/Telematic and by entering "Navigation Guidance" section.



STEP THREE

On completion of the initialization, eject the Telematic System CD ROM and return it to its case. You now need to insert the Map CD into the drive, the Map CD must remain in the drive at all times for the navigation system to operate, you will receive a "WAIT" message while the system acquires satellites and once this has been completed you may then enter your destination, again using the MENU function as previously used, for the Navigation to commence. By referring to the Operation Manual, supplied with the vehicle, you can customize your navigation requirements to include Hotels, Parks, Sporting grounds and Fuel stations etc.
